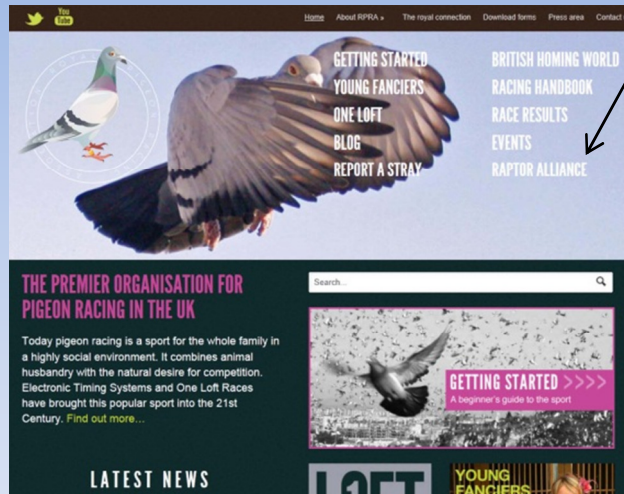


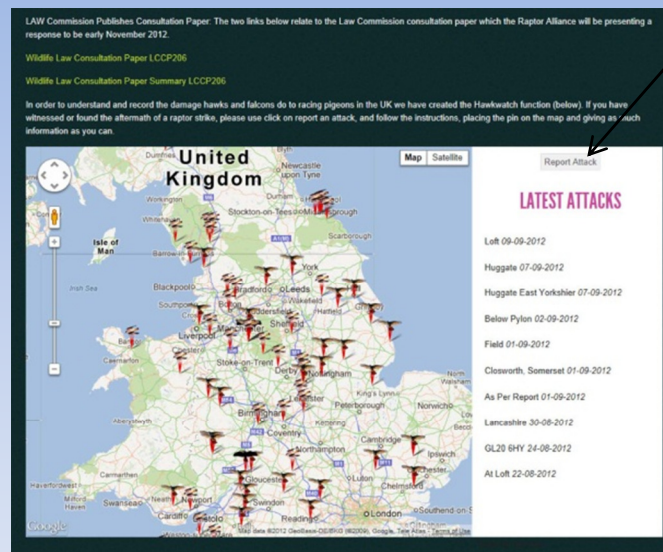
## Guide to Reporting a Raptor Attack on the Hawkwatch Page of the RPRa Website

Log on to the RPRa website [www.rpra.org](http://www.rpra.org)

Click on the **Raptor Alliance** link (bottom of the right hand column on the Main Menu)



On the next page, click on the **Report Attack** button (top of the right hand panel next to the map)



You can then drag the pointer to your location (zoom in using the +/- on the scale – top left of map)
