Chris was more than a competitor - he was a legend amongst us. From his beginnings at age 12 in 1963, through decades of unwavering dedication, he built a strain and reputation that resonate across both club and international flights. Fellow fanciers will recall:

- **Snydale Express**: Winner of the National Flying Club Grand National Tarbes 2005 4,066 birds record 725 miles, winning by 91 ypm; 1st Section K, 1st Open NFC.
- "My 28" arguably his finest racer bred from the Eric Fox line; 4×1st as a young bird and top 10 open positions from long-distance events.
- Repeated highest prize-winner in his club 26 out of 28 years. Multiple 1st Section wins in National Flying Club and British Barcelona Club.
- Marathon and international success: Performances from 50 up to 863 miles; his birds have bred winners abroad in France, Ireland, Bulgaria, Romania, Spain, and Tenerife.
- Strong foundation lines: Janssens, Leen Boers, Eric Fox, Pearson & Dransfield a family strain developed to thrive across distance, time, and testing conditions.

These pigeons are the product of a lifetime's selection - condition, feather, stamina, intelligence, orientation. A true student of the sport, Chris bred birds to last and excel, and his record reflects that.
